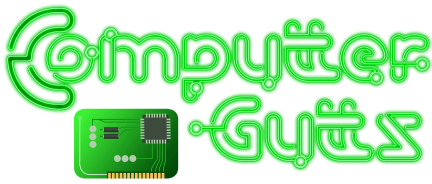
## Position Overview
